As a new member, I understand that I must be in my fifth semester of French. Middle School French counts as two semesters.							
I understand that to become a member, I have earned a grade of A for at least 4 semesters of French (88% in honors classes not counting extra 7 points / 90% in on-level classes). Teachers will check transcripts to verify.

I understand that previous members must pay \$25 and new members must pay \$35 dues this year which includes a new T-shirt. Payments will be made online and the link to the online school payment will be communicated through our FHS Microsoft Team. After student turns in this signed agreement and transcripts are checked for new members, students will be added to this FHS Microsoft Team and they will be able to access the Online School Payment. Deadline to turn in this form to a French teacher is November 3. Please pay dues by November 10. This will allow us to order T-shirts.							
I understand that first-time members will be inducted at a ceremony during the second semester. I further understand that induction alone does not guarantee active membership or a cord for graduation.							
I understand that to join and maintain FHS membership, I must remain in an in-person French class at Cambridge High School. Our World Language Honor Societies are available for the students we teach, for whom we, Cambridge faculty, work diligently to create meaningful and engaging learning environments. Students in online classes do not engage in the live instruction and practice we provide; therefore, they are ineligible for membership in the honor societies.							
I understand that to maintain active membership, I need to pay annual dues and perform at least 10 service hours per year. All of these service hours must be pre-approved and cannot be used in other organizations (with the exception of International Skills Diploma Seal). At least three of these hours (per year) must be served by participating in online conversations with Haitian students who are learning English at the HHE Institute in Haiti. These online conversations are in the late afternoons, early evenings and sometimes on Saturdays. Students new to FHS will need to complete a 1hour training prior to doing their online conversations.							
I understand that only active members from the previous year may apply for leadership/board positions.							
I understand that in order to receive an honor cord at graduation, seniors must be <u>active</u> members in FHS their senior year, satisfying all of the stipulations in this agreement. Seniors who qualify for an honor cord are required to pay their dues as well as \$13 for their cord.							
I understand that to receive ongoing FHS info., I must join the FHS remind. Text @fre23-24 to 81010. I must also regularly check our FHS Microsoft Team to stay current with communications.							
I understand that according to the mission of our national organization AATF (American Association of Teachers of French) which governs the National French Honor Society, portions of student dues will be used for T-shirts, AATF or FHS awards, annual membership fees, celebrations/ceremonies/events/activities in FHS or occasionally for resources used in the classroom that promote advocacy and understanding of the francophone world and cultures and foster connections with francophone communities.
